Montreal, June 13, 2022 — The Fondation des jeunes de la DPJ is pleased to announce that it will be supporting seven projects in various Quebec regions this year through its new regional initiatives support fund. Through its working relationships already established with organizations and foundations around the province, the Fondation will be supporting projects that help young people who are transitioning to adult life.

Lending a hand to help more: a collaboration to help young people

The Fondation launched a call for proposals in April to organizations in Quebec regions to provide financial support to their initiatives and increase their impact with young people of the DYP. "This appeal succeeded beyond our expectations!" notes Fabienne Audette, General Manager of the Fondation. "More than 20 projects were submitted. This success demonstrates the relevance of the fund set up by the Fondation to support regional initiatives. This response shows that the needs of young people of the DYP are very real—wherever they may be in Quebec."

Projects that meet the recommendations of the Laurent Commission

For this initial \$200,000 funding envelope, the allocation committee composed of social services, youth protection and social development experts has selected projects that enable the transition to adult life.

Preparing young people of the DYP for independence was identified as a major issue in the Laurent Commission's report. Around 2,000 young people in the DYP's care reach the age of majority every year. The initiatives that receive financial support from the Fondation are in line with the fundamental focus on school perseverance, development of independent living and residential stability, employability, and the acquisition of skills, self-esteem and healthy life habits.
